Christmas Market

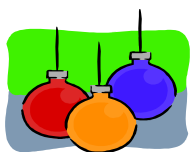

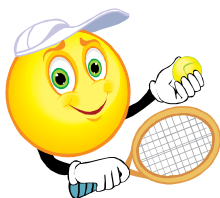
• Flippaball

Selling of Uniform—New and Second Hand

• New CBS Uniform Items

We have relooked at the selling process of our school uniform and as from 1 January 2012 it will change. **Please do not contact the School Uniform Company after this date.**

Campbells Bay School will be selling new uniform items direct to you as parents. We will continue operating the selling of the new uniform on Tuesday mornings between 8.00am - 9.00pm. As from 25 January you will be able to purchase and collect your new uniform items on this morning direct from the Performing Arts Room.

There will be a small increase in the price per uniform item. Prices have not increased in the last two years, only GST prices. This small increase is due to covering costs for a eftpos machine, terminal charge and merchant fees and also administration costs.

The PTA will be running a second-hand uniform sale to coincide with the selling of new CBS uniforms and also school stationary sale in January 2012. This will be held in the PA room on **Wednesday, 25 January 2012**.

• Second Hand CBS Uniform items

The PTA will be selling second hand uniforms on your behalf on **Wednesday, 25 January 2012** (same day as new uniform sales). Please follow the instructions below.

- ◆ You will need to bring your clean, second hand uniforms to the school office between now and Friday 16 December. The last day of term will be a mufti day so you can bring any last pieces up to school on the last day of term.
- ◆ Please decide whether you would like to donate or sell the item/s. We're grateful for any donations!
- ◆ Please set a price for each item you wish to sell, taking into account its condition. This will be clearly labelled and attached to the item with a pin, and your contact and banking details
- ◆ The PTA will deduct 20% from the total value of sale to cover administration costs, and as a fund raiser for the school.
- ◆ After each sale, the PTA will either credit your bank account or send a cheque for the items sold.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS FULLY!

It is essential that all items of clothing can be traced to vendors through all aspects of administration and sale. This will ensure that the correct money for sold items and any unsold items are returned to the vendor. The PTA will not take responsibility for any loss where instructions have not been followed.

- 1) Please wash all items for sale.
- 2) Each item of clothing needs to be labelled in the following way:
 - Cut out 5cm x 5cm squares of cardboard (cereal boxes are ideal – paper is not strong enough)
 - On the cardboard write a brief description of the item, size and price. We will issue and add your registration number.
 - Attach the cardboard square to the clothing with a strong silver safety pin (the little gold ones are not strong enough and please no sewing pins or staples).
- 3) Place all labelled items of clothing for sale into one plastic bag. If more than one bag is needed, please tie them together.
- 4) Complete the registration form and put inside the plastic bag. Fill in the table on the reverse as follows, leaving the Date/Qty Sold columns free for administration purposes. Please keep pricing to a rounded dollar (no cents), as this keeps change simple at sale time. **If you are donating all items please still enclose this form notifying us of this.**
- 5) Deliver your bag of clothing with the registration form to the school office on or before 16 December 2011.
